## 2012 Libero Designation and Libero Serve

\*Our region is implementing the new “two Liberos” rule. Only one libero can be on the court at any time. One libero may replace the other libero, however the player that was originally replaced must return to the court as normal.

\*The Libero designations will be for each set, and can be changed for subsequent sets in the match for the entire match.

### **LIBERO SERVE**

\*The libero MAY serve in all competitions this year EXCEPT the Region Qualifiers at the end of the season.

\*BOTH Liberos MAY serve.

\* EACH Libero be allowed to serve in a different positions. However, both MAY NOT be on the court at the same time.

\*BOTH Liberos are permitted to serve. When one Libero is on the court and his/her team wins a rally and rotates, the second Libero (on the bench) will replace the server during that same dead-ball AND the Acting Libero (on the court) is then also replaced by the front-row player.

(In other words, two separate Libero replacements occur without a completed rally between them: the Libero on the court is replaced by the regular player in the front row, and the Libero on the bench replaces the server.)

### **TRACKING THE LIBERO SERVE**

\*A triangle will be placed around the POSITION number in which the libero(s) serves and also around any points that the libero(s) scores in the scoring column.

\*The libero tracker will need to track BOTH liberos and who they go in/out for.

Use L1 and L2 to designate Acting libero and second libero.
